### INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING RENEWAL APPLICATION

1. **Submit your renewal at least 60 days prior to the expiration of your registration to provide sufficient time for processing.**
2. Input enclosed fee amount.
3. If your address is new and has not yet been reported to the Bureau, check the box in the Address Section.
4. If you possess a current, valid BSIS firearms permit, input the permit number (including two-letter prefix) and expiration date. Please note, the expiration date for registrations associated with a Bureau firearm permit must be synchronized with the expiration date of the firearm permit. The synchronization may result in the registration expiration date reflecting more or less than the two-year period. In this event, the renewal fee will be prorated.
